**NOTICE**

Following are the rules for use of the Library with effect from 29/06/2009

- 1) Working hours of the Library will be as follows:
  - Monday to Friday -- 8.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.
  - Saturday -- 8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
- 2) Issuing days for home lending will be as follows:
  - a) F.E. -- Wednesday & Saturday
  - b) S.E. -- Tuesday & Friday

- c)T.E. -- Monday & Thursday
- d)B.E., M.E. -- All working days  
and Research students

- 3) Issuing hours for home lending will be as follows:
  - Monday to Friday -- 9.00 a.m. to 5.30 p.m.
  - Saturday -- 9.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.
  
- 4) F.E. to B.E. students can get issued three books at a time.  
M.E. and Research students can get issued four books at a time.
  
- 5) Books will be issued for a period of fifteen days.
  
- 6) No renewal of books issued, will be allowed.
  
- 7) The books issued can be returned to the Library on any working day.
  
- 8) Fine for overdue books :
  - a) For first 15 days -- Rs.1.00 per day
  - b) After 15 days -- Rs.2.00 per day
  
- 9) For overnight issue one Book/CD/DVD / Floppy will be issued against Identity Card.
  
- 10) Timings for overnight issue :
  - Monday to Friday -- 5.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.
  - Saturday --12.00 p.m. to 12.30 p.m.
  
- 11) Book/CD/DVD/Floppy issued for overnight has to be returned on next working day before 1.00 p.m.
  
- 12) Fine for overdue for overnight issue will be Rs.10.00 per day.
  
- 13) Students should use the books carefully and see that books are not damaged or spoiled. In case the book is damaged, he/she will be liable for a fine.
  
- 14) In case the issued book is lost by the student he/she will have to replace the book by a new copy of the latest edition. If the book is out of print or not available in the market he/she has to pay double the cost of the book lost or as asked by the Librarian depending on the reference value of the book.
  
- 15) In case the CD/DVD/Floppy is damaged/lost by the student he/she has to pay for the same as per the existing rules.
  
- 16) Matter regarding missing pages from the book, periodical issue, should be informed to the Library staff as soon as noticed / the book is taken in possession.

17) Timings for Reading Hall

Monday to Friday -- 8.30a.m. to 6.30a.m.

Saturday -- 8.30a.m. to 1.00p.m.

During Preparation -- 8.30a.m. to 9.30p.m.

Leave (inclusive Sundays and Holidays).

18) Students have to produce identity card on demand in the Library. Entry to the Library & Reading Hall is restricted to C.O.E.T. students.

19) Students have to use Depository to keep belongings at their own risk. They can bring in only notebook and loose papers.

20) Students have to sign the Entry Register before entering the Library. There is a separate Entry Register for the Reading Hall and the Periodicals Section.

21) Periodicals will be available for Library reference only.

22) Photocopying facility will be made available only within the Library at the rate of Rs.1.00 per copy.

23) Internet facility timings:

Monday to Friday : 9.00a.m. to 5.30p.m.

Saturday : 9.00a.m. to 12.30p.m.

24) Students from the reserved category who are getting Central Government Scholarship can avail the Book-Bank Facility. For the details they should see the Notice for the Book-Bank facility put up for every semester.
