All students' admission will be confirmed only after the submission of duly signed hardcopy of online antiragging form along with admission form. The admission committee is requested to ensure the submission of anti ragging form at the time of admission.

Important note: In pursuance to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 8.5.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the University Grant Commission framed "UGC Regulation on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher educational institutions, 2009" which were notified on 17th June, 2009 and are to be mandatorily followed by all universities and colleges.
