

## **Industry-Institute Cell Report (A.Y. 2017-18)**

### **Training**

The following Training sessions / guest lectures/ seminars were arranged for the students in AY 17-18.

1. Seminar on Changing Trends in Campus recruitment Process by Mr Vishwajit Kashid, Recruitment Expert, from EXFO was conducted on Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> July 2017
2. TPO Orientation for BE was conducted in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> week of July.
3. Campus Recruitment Training of 40 hours by IMS was conducted for BE students in July and August 2017.
4. FNAT - Firstnaukri Aptitude Test (FNAT) was conducted on 3/9/17 for BE and on 25/3/18 for TE respectively.
5. Seminar on GD & PI skills by TIME was conducted for BE on 8/9/17.
6. Seminar on Aptitude Test, GD & PI skills by IMS was conducted for BE Printing Class on 8/9/17.
7. An Orientation on Opportunities in Construction Industries by Gleeds was conducted for TE on 12/9/17.
8. Aptitude Test Practice Sessions at individual Dept level were conducted in Sept. 17

13. A Seminar was conducted on GRE by TIME on Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> February 2018 for TE students.
14. A Mock Aptitude Test and Career Guidance (GATE) was conducted by Wani Institute on 15/2/18 for TE students.
15. Campus Recruitment Training of 40 hours by Mr Neeraj Athavale of Manudyam and alumni of PVG is conducted for TE students from Jan 2018 to March 2018. The sessions were conducted 4 hours per week per class. The sessions will restart from July 2018 to cover remaining syllabus. ## **Industry-Institute Interaction**
