
POLICY DOCUMENT ON CLEAN AND GREEN CAMPUS.

So Let's Become A Responsible Pvgian And Citizen Too !!!

1. Every teaching and non-teaching faculty in the Institute must be aware that, to facilitate efficient waste management, there are plastic and paper waste dumps are placed at various locations in the campus so that waste segregation follows at source,.
2. All the plastic waste generated, which can include unusable pens, pen caps, pencil, compass box, damaged carry bags, plastic folders, files, pen stand etc. are to be put in the plastic waste dump only.
3. The Institute has a tie up with plastic recycling agencies, which does a periodical collection of plastic waste generated.
4. Institute has also signed an MOU with paper scrap recyclers which collects the paper scrap periodically and works to facilitate scientific paper recycling.
 - a) With an understanding and observation that, in spite of attempt made by everyone to save paper, being an academic institute, there is a lot of paper scrap generated on daily basis. It is therefore instructed that all the paper waste generated must be handed over to paper recycling agency.
 - b) No paper should be crumpled or thrown in the dust bin. Instead, it should be put in Paper waste bin. For the confidential papers the shredding facility will be provided by the agency during the collection.
5. Also, the Institute has signed MOU with e-waste recycling agency. Various departments are required to ensure proper e-waste segregation & collection.
6. The electronic waste collected needs to be dumped in the small compartment room located on the terrace of main building when enough amount of e-waste collected, the e-waste recycler could be called upon for collection
7. All the employees and the students studying in the Institute should put a total ban on single use plastic and avoid using plastic in every possible way.

8. Leaves litter and other green waste is being composted using composting units indigenously designed and made by faculty and students
9. Canteen leftover waste is been handed over separately to PMC waste collector.
10. Canteen Kitchen waste is composted using using vermicomposting unit
11. Tree plantation and green landscaping is highly encouraged within campus and nurturing of plants and trees is ensure through maintenance on daily basis. The Heritage trees and native species are conserved to increase the carbon sinks in the campus.
12. The electric vehicle use is promoted by providing free charging using solar powered EV charging station.
13. The Institute has received recognition and award as Green College Clean College, and all of us dutifully need to take every single effort to meet the requirements of green and ecofriendly campus.
