Activities in association with Leading Industries

Atlas Copco

- Atlas Copco offered internship and placement to 3 Electrical and 6 Mechanical students of 2024 batch. They offered Krutikka Scholarship worth Rs 50000/- to female topper student Samruddhi Sutar from Electrical 2023 batch. It also offered job to 2 Electrical and 4 Mechanical students from 2023 batch through internship.

- Pre-placement Training - It is an academia-industry partnership programme by KPIT for placed students to make them industry ready. It gives them an opportunity for technical training with focus on three tracks viz. Object Oriented Programming, Embedded Systems and Model Based Design.

Rubicon

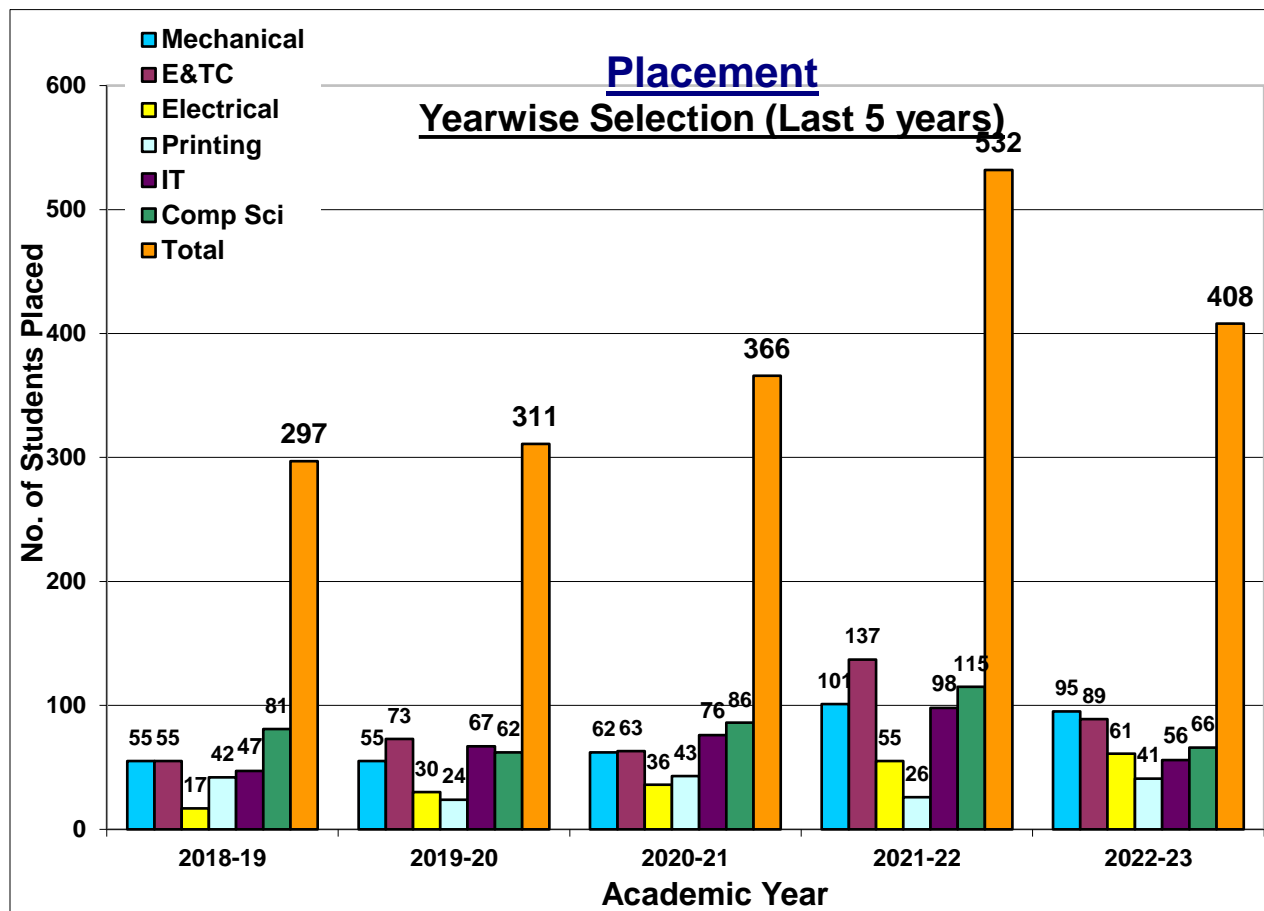
